

**THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF TEMISKAMING SHORES  
BY-LAW NO. 2004-114  
BEING A BY-LAW TO ADOPT AN INTERIM EMERGENCY PLAN**

**WHEREAS**, The Emergency Management Act S.O. 2002, Section 2.1(1) provides that every municipality shall develop and implement an emergency management program and the council of the municipality shall by by-law adopt the emergency management program;

**AND WHEREAS**, the Act makes provision for the Head of Council to declare that an emergency exists in the community or in any part thereof, and also provides the Head of Council with authority to take such action or make such orders as he/she considers necessary and not contrary to law, to implement the emergency response plan and respond to an emergency;

**AND WHEREAS**, the Act authorizes employees of a community to respond to an emergency in accordance with the emergency response plan where an emergency exists but has not yet been declared to exist;

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of The Corporation of the City of Temiskaming Shores, at the August 30, 2004 meeting, considered and approved the recommendations contained in Administrative Report No. PPS-034-04 respecting an Interim Emergency Response Plan;

**AND WHEREAS**, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Temiskaming Shores has recognized that the municipality is in the process of complying and implementing an emergency management program, and deems it necessary to have in place an interim emergency response plan.

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of The Corporation of the City of Temiskaming Shores enacts as follows:

1. That the Council of The Corporation of the City of Temiskaming Shores adopts an *Interim Emergency Response Plan* attached hereto as Appendix "1".
2. That any By-law inconsistent with the provisions of the City of Temiskaming Shores By-law No. 114 is deemed to be repealed.
