

VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITY COMMITTEE OF ADJUSTMENT

The City of Temiskaming Shores Committee of Adjustment is a 6 member quasi-judicial body, which reviews applications, conducts public hearings, and makes decisions with respect to Consent to Sever and Minor Variance Applications; pursuant to the *Planning Act*. The Committee is seeking an interested individual to fill a vacant position from January to December 2010.

The Committee of Adjustment holds public hearings on the last Wednesday of each month at 1:30 p.m. at City Hall. In accordance with the *Planning Act*, the City pays an honorarium of \$40 per hearing to assist with the costs of site visits, and time spent preparing for and attending the hearing.

Training will be provided in-house by the Committee of Adjustment with occasional opportunities to attend relevant workshops and conferences.
