The commitment and participation of 25 volunteers are required to assist in the following areas:

Stagers (8) to assist with:

- Set-up and tear down of tents and media risers and audio/video gear.
- The torchbearer corridor when the community torchbearer arrives.

Security (6) to assist with:

- Set up and tear down of “back of house” security fencing, media coral and directional signage.
- Staff security checkpoint positions.

Setters (2) to assist the hospitality team with:

- Set-up, tear down, and cleaning of the green room and production tent.

Show Runners (3) to assist the celebration crew and:

- Must have a strong working knowledge of neighbourhood and access to transportation.
- Assist the operations manager with general items.

Mascots (2):

- Will be trained to perform in costume as the Vancouver 2010 Olympic mascots
- The height ranges to perform are 5’1” to 5’4” and 5’10 to 6’2”.

Mascot handlers (2):

- Are required to be able to lift 18 kilograms (30 pounds).
- Unpack, organize and repack the mascot costumes.
- Guide and manage the movements of the 2 Olympic mascots during their appearances.

Media Relations (2) to assist with:

- The set up and control of the media zone.
- Refer media questions to the lead media specialist on site.
