

**THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF TEMISKAMING SHORES
BY-LAW NO.2007-024
BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 2005-004, A BY-
LAW FOR THE OPERATION OF MUNICIPALLY OWNED
CEMETERIES.**

WHEREAS the Cemeteries Act, R.S.O., 1990, chapter C.4 provides regulations for the acquisition, operation and management of Cemeteries;

AND WHEREAS The Corporation of the City of Temiskaming Shores is licensed to operate, maintain and regulate four (4) municipally owned cemeteries;

AND WHEREAS Council of The Corporation of the City of Temiskaming Shores adopted By-law No. 2005-004, a by-law for the regulating of municipally owned cemeteries;

AND WHEREAS Council of The Corporation of the City of Temiskaming Shores deems it expedient to amend By-law No. 2004-005;

AND WHEREAS in accordance with Section 50 (3) of the Revised Cemeteries Act, R.S.O., 1990, c. C.4, no by-law made by a cemetery owner is effective until it is filed with and approved by the Registrar.

AND WHEREAS Council of The Corporation of the City of Temiskaming Shores considered Administrative Report LS-01-2007 and adopted the recommendations as contained in the report;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Temiskaming Shores enacts the following as a by-law:

1. That Item **I) 2. *MARKERS*** be amended to include the following marker size restrictions for a cremation lot:

- maximum size of marker for a cremation lot 45.72 cm x 60.96 cm (18" x 24")

2. That the wording under Item **K) 9. *MORTUARY REGULATIONS*** be replaced with the following:

It is recommended for health reasons that all bodies stored in the vault be embalmed or in a sealing pouch.

3. That the said regulations come into force and effect on the date approval has been received from the Registrar in accordance with Section 50 (3) of the Cemeteries Act, R.S.O., 1990, c. C.4; and

4. That the Clerk of the City of Temiskaming Shores is hereby authorized to make any minor modifications or corrections of an administrative, numerical, grammatical, semantical or descriptive nature or kind to the by-law and schedule as may be deemed necessary after the passage of this by-law.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and FINALLY PASSED this 13th day of February, 2007.
