Mayor and Council:

On June 20, 2022, Staff was presented with a letter from Phippen Waste Management requesting that a 3.5% increase be considered to the current contract for waste services. The justification for the increase is related to increasing costs associated with fuel, oil parts labour and other general costs.

At the Corporate Services Meeting held on July 22, 2022, Phippen Waste Management presented their letter/request resulting in direction given to staff to provide the committee with a cost analysis breakdown related to the impact of the request.

At the Corporate Services Committee Meeting held on August 11, 2022, the Phippen Waste Management request and cost analysis was discussed resulting in the following recommendation:

The Corporate Services Committee hereby recommends that Council consider a one-time lump sum payment of \$36,011.95 be paid to Phippen Waste Management for the CPI Adjustment Request in Schedules A-D of the Phippen Waste Management contract, and further that the City renegotiate the contract with Phippen Waste Management as a result of the new landfill site opening in 2023.
