

# PW-RFT-001-2023 Request for Tender Asphalt Markings and Symbols

## Addendum No. 1 (to the Request for Tender Document)

The Request for Tender (RFT) is modified as set forth in this Addendum. The original RFT Documents and any previously issued addenda remain in full force and effect, except as modified by this Addendum, which is hereby made part of the RFT. Respondents shall take this Addendum into consideration when preparing and submitting its Tender Package.

## **Questions and Answers**

The following questions and answers are provided as information to clarify questions raised about the Request for Tender.

## 1.1 **Question**: 7.9 Hours of Work

When it comes to safety in high traffic areas (specifically intersections), it might be worth a look at revising the hours of work on the tender. However, I completely understand if it is unchangeable. Please let me know what your thoughts are on this.

**Answer:** All work will be done during appropriate hours to get the job done. High traffic areas should be done when the least amount of traffic is on the road. The City will permit contractors to perform work through the night. Proper notice and detour routes shall be established.

## 1.2 **Question:** 8. Scope of Work

Is there any consequence for not meeting the July 1 weather permitting deadline? Deadline has an impact on our pricing so I would like some clarification here.

**Answer:** Time is of the essence. The contractor shall endeavor to complete the work by July 1st. Certain factors may lead to missing that deadline which will be discussed between the City and Contractor at that time. There will be no liquidated damages on this contract.



## 1.3 **Question**: 8. Scope of Work

It was noticed various accessible blue boxes outlined / stenciled in white last season. Is the tender accurate in dictating yellow outlines and pictograms? Different colours of traffic paint have significantly different prices so I would like some clarification on this. I should mention that we don't bid any work unless we have enough WB inventory on hand to satisfy the requirements on time as outlined in a tender.

**Answer**: The City's definition of an Accessible Blue Box is a blue parking spot with outline and stencil pictogram in yellow paint.

The City requires Yellow paint as it was recommended from the Accessibility Committee for Low Vision persons using these locations.

Contractors must have a sufficient supply of yellow paint to meet the quantities.

## 1.4 **Question:** 9. Traffic Control

It was observed in 2022 the contractor was aided by city employees to perform traffic control. Taking this into consideration, must tender submissions adhere to the requirement that all labour and supervision will be supplied by the contractor as per the tender specifications.

**Answer:** Yes, the contractor must provide protection for traffic control to satisfy MTO Book 7. They must also provide protection of painted areas for a sufficient amount of time.

## 1.5 **Question:** Section 4 – STATO Path Symbols

Through previous work on STATO path, the quantities of bicycles and stop blocks listed in section 4 of the tender are different from the quantities previously painted.

- Has the STATO working area changed since it was last painted?
- Does this work still require 2 different sized bike symbols (Georgina vs Lakeshore sizes)?
- Are the Wabi bridge white bike and sharrow markings still to be painted inside a green box (same as 2022 specifications)?

Please indicate to ensure we have enough paint and stencils fabricated to bid the tender with confidence in our ability to complete the job on time.



### Answer:

- 1. The work area has not changed. Quantity of Bicycle Symbols are based on needs. In 2023, 100 symbols will be repainted. After review, the Bike Stop Blocks will be updated with the quantity of 24. Please find attached Appendix A, updated Form of Tender.
- 2. There will be no bike symbols required for Georgina. All sizes should be related to the Lakeshore sizes.
- 3. Yes, the white bike and sharrow markings are still to be painted inside a green box.

## 1.6 **Question:** Thermoplastic Applications:

Last season it was noticed that a few of the tendered markings were completed with thermoplastics. Will there be any adjustments to the tendered specifications to allow for material other than waterborne traffic paint in 2023?

**Answer:** It is not required to bid with thermoplastics for markings / symbols. If the contractor has value-added services, they wish to present at the time of bidding they may do so. Contractors are expected to bid with the specifications as per the tender document.
