### Ontario Blue Box Transition - January 1, 2025

#### Residential Curbside Collection Service

Effective January 1, 2025, the recycling program in the City of Temiskaming Shores will be managed by Circular Materials Ontario (CMO), under the requirements of the Government of Ontario Blue Box Regulation 391/21.

There will be no change to:

- ◆ materials residents can recycle
- ◆ recycling pickup schedule dates

### Ontario Blue Box Transition - January 1, 2025

#### Operational Changes – Recycling Facility (547 Barr Drive)

Effective January 1, 2025, the recycling program in the City of Temiskaming Shores will be managed by Circular Materials Ontario (CMO), under the requirements of the Government of Ontario Blue Box Regulation 391/21.

Effective February 1, 2025, the recycling facility located at 547 Barr Drive will be closed for public use. The depot recycling bins currently located outside of this facility will be relocated to the New Liskeard Landfill (704165 Rockley Road). Any excess recyclable material may be deposited for free at this location.

The City of Temiskaming Shores has entered into an agreement with Phippen Waste Management for the lease of the recycling facility located at 547 Barr Drive from February 1, 2025, until April 30, 2025. Industrial, Commercial or Institutional (ICI) owners currently using the facility or depot bins are encouraged to reach out to Phippen Waste Management to make drop-off arrangements.

The City of Temiskaming Shores is investigating options moving forward as the requirements of the Government of Ontario Blue Box Regulation will change how the current recycling program operates. More information will be provided as it becomes available.

### Ontario Blue Box Transition - January 1, 2025

#### Industrial, Commercial and Institutional (ICI) Curbside Recycling Collection

As of January 1, 2025, Temiskaming Shores' recycling program will be managed by Circular Materials Ontario (CMO), under the requirements of the new Provincial Governments Blue Box Regulation 391/21. Within the regulation, CMO is not required to collect from any ICI establishments, however, will allow the ICI material to be mixed with residential material from January 1, 2025 until December 31, 2025.

Please visit the City's website for further information as to how this will affect your establishment should you be part of the current curbside recycling collection program.

The City of Temiskaming Shores is committed to investigating options moving forward as it is recognized that the new Provincial Blue Box Regulation will have financial implications to the ICI establishments currently part of the program.

## Curbside Collection

### Winter Collection - Safety Tips



During extreme weather conditions (snowfall, wind blown snow, freezing rain, black ice, etc.,) your garbage and recycling collection may be delayed; however, Phippen Waste Management does their best to ensure regular collection remain on time.

Use extra care when using the rollout garbage and recycling bins in slippery conditions caused by snow and or ice.	Avoid placing the bins out the night before and remove bins from the road as soon as possible.
Clear the bins of snow and ice to ensure the lid opens when emptied.	Clear a space for the placement of bins and make the bin accessible and visible to the collector.

**City of Temiskaming Shores Winter Operations Plan | 2024-2025**

Although winter weather is often random and unpredictable, city snow removal efforts are not. The city is committed to providing a high level of snow removal service throughout the winter season, with consideration to safety, environmental and budget concerns. Your cooperation in helping to keep streets clean and safe is appreciated.

**Weather Monitoring Season** | October 1, 2024 to April 30, 2025

**Winter Maintenance Season** | On or about November 1, 2024 to April 15, 2025.

- Priority Road Routes**
- ◆ A maximum level of approximately 5cm of fallen snow is permitted to remain on the road.
  - ◆ Cleanup to be completed approximately 6 hours after end of snowfall.
  - ◆ Ice formation prevention starts approximately 8 hours previous to an alleged formation of ice.
  - ◆ Treatment of icy roadways expires in 4 hours.

- Tips**
- ◆ Please remove all objects, including basketball nets from the roadways and sidewalks. Objects obstruct snow removal and could be damaged if left on the roadway or sidewalk.
  - ◆ Public Works phone system is now set up for Winter Mode. When you call, 705-647-6220 you will be directed to Public Works between 8:00am - 4:30pm.

**Youth Gym Admission Policy** | Effective January 1, 2025  
 The starting age for the Waterfront Pool & Fitness Centre is 12. There are no exceptions to this rule. All children ages 12-15 who are using the gym must schedule a Facility Orientation with a Trainer on our Orientation Trainer list.  
 If you are 12-15 and are a current holder of a gym membership or punch card, your membership will be placed on hold beginning January 1st, 2025 until you can complete an Orientation with one of our listed Trainers. Once completed, your membership will be extended from the days missed.

- ◆ All residents are required to obtain a Burning Permit.
- ◆ Burning Permits are required each year from January 1 to December 31.
- ◆ Daytime Burning IS NOT permitted from April 1 until October 31.
- ◆ Permitted burn times are between 6:00pm and 8:00am

*How do I keep myself and my loved ones safe?*

- Ensure woodstoves, fireplaces and fireplace inserts are installed by a **qualified technician** according to **manufacturer's instructions**.
- Have your heating system, vents and chimneys inspected and cleaned annually by a **qualified service technician**.
- Ensure all outside heating vents are **not blocked**.

Install **smoke and carbon monoxide alarms** on every storey of your home.

**Test them every month.**



- Allow ashes from your woodstove or fireplace to cool before emptying them into a **metal container** with a tight-fitting lid. **Keep the container outside.**
- **Always use a fire screen around the fireplace!**
