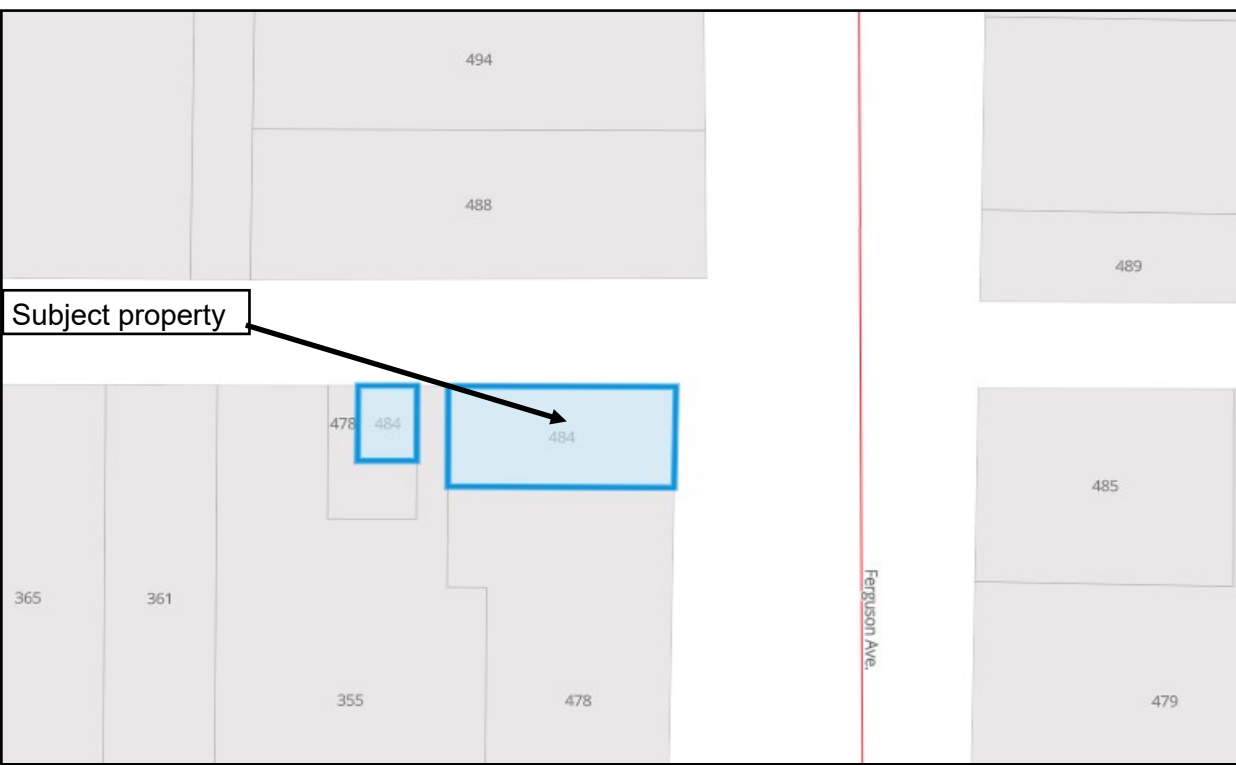
Place: Council Chambers at City Hall, 325 Farr Drive, Haileybury

Cemetery Clean-up

The City of Temiskaming Shores will be conducting a Spring Clean-up to ensure our cemeteries remain a respectful and well-maintained space for visitors.

During this time, any items that have become damaged or unsightly will be removed to facilitate grounds maintenance. Families are encouraged to retrieve any person items they wish to keep before **Tuesday, May 20, 2025**. Following this date, staff will store large items for 60 days.

Items subject to removal

- ◆ Decorations that have become withered or unsightly (including artificial flowers)
- ◆ Prohibited materials (breakable items)
- ◆ Damaged items (such as solar lights)
- ◆ Overgrown vegetation
- ◆ Non-permitted structures (such as plastic plot borders)

Program Qualifications (proof is required)

- ◆ Animal Owner must be a resident of the City of Temiskaming Shores.
- ◆ Animal Owner total household income must be below the following amounts:
 - 1 income earner: **\$44,120**
 - 2 income earner: **\$53,698**
- ◆ Animal must be registered with Temiskaming Shores Animal Services or be a Farm Animal.

Registration Required

- ◆ Registration is open on a first come first served basis.
- ◆ Proof of program qualifications must be submitted prior to the clinic date.
- ◆ Register for the Community Care Clinic by contacting the City Animal Control Officer.
