This year’s theme, “People, Purpose, Presence,” highlights three cornerstone ideals that motivate public works professionals to serve in their communities every day. Meeting the needs of people is what gives public works its sense of purpose. Many times, public works professionals will never meet those whose lives have been impacted because when things are going right, no one knows that public works is there. Yet, with or without fanfare, public works is ever present, working in the background to advance quality of life for all.

Public Works

2025 Roadway Resurfacing Program
Council for the City of Temiskaming Shores has approved an agreement with Miller Paving Limited in the amount of \$500,000 for the 2025 Roads Program. This agreement allows the Public Works Department to continue the momentum of upgrading road surfaces within the City of Temiskaming Shores.

This year the City will update approximately 1.8 lane kilometers of road and approximately 10,000 m2 of surface treated roads. Miller Paving will begin work starting as soon as possible. Roads may be temporarily reduced to one lane in some areas. Please be cautious in the area around construction workers.

In 2025, we will see the following sections of roads surfaces being improved

- ♦ Whitewood Avenue from High Street to Golding Street
- ♦ Cecil Street from Rorke Avenue to Georgina Avenue
- ♦ Russell from Rorke Avenue to Georgina Avenue
- ♦ Surface Treatment Program
 - ♦ Quarry Road from West Road to Lakeview Avenue
 - ♦ Rockley Road to the New Liskeard Landfill Site

The City is aware there are other roads in our Municipality that require resurfacing. However these roads were selected based on an infrastructure review and the Asset Management Plan. Council has committed to completing work on separate capital projects such as, Golf Course Road Rehabilitation and Farr Park Project, which are independent from the Roads Program. The City also has a patching program that will be ongoing throughout the spring and summer months. Thank you for your patience and understanding during the construction season!

Fire Hydrant Flushing | May 20, 2025
The City of Temiskaming Shores Environmental Crews of the Public Works Department will be carrying out maintenance programs, flushing and testing of fire hydrants throughout the municipal waster distribution systems commencing on May 20, 2025.

The work may cause come discolouration in the water; however, the effect should be minimal. If a coloured water problem is encountered in your water service line, flushing the service by letting the water run for a period of time should cure the problem. If the coloured water persists, please contact the Public Works Department for assistance. Thank you for your co-operation as the Environmental Cre Carries out this important maintenance activity.

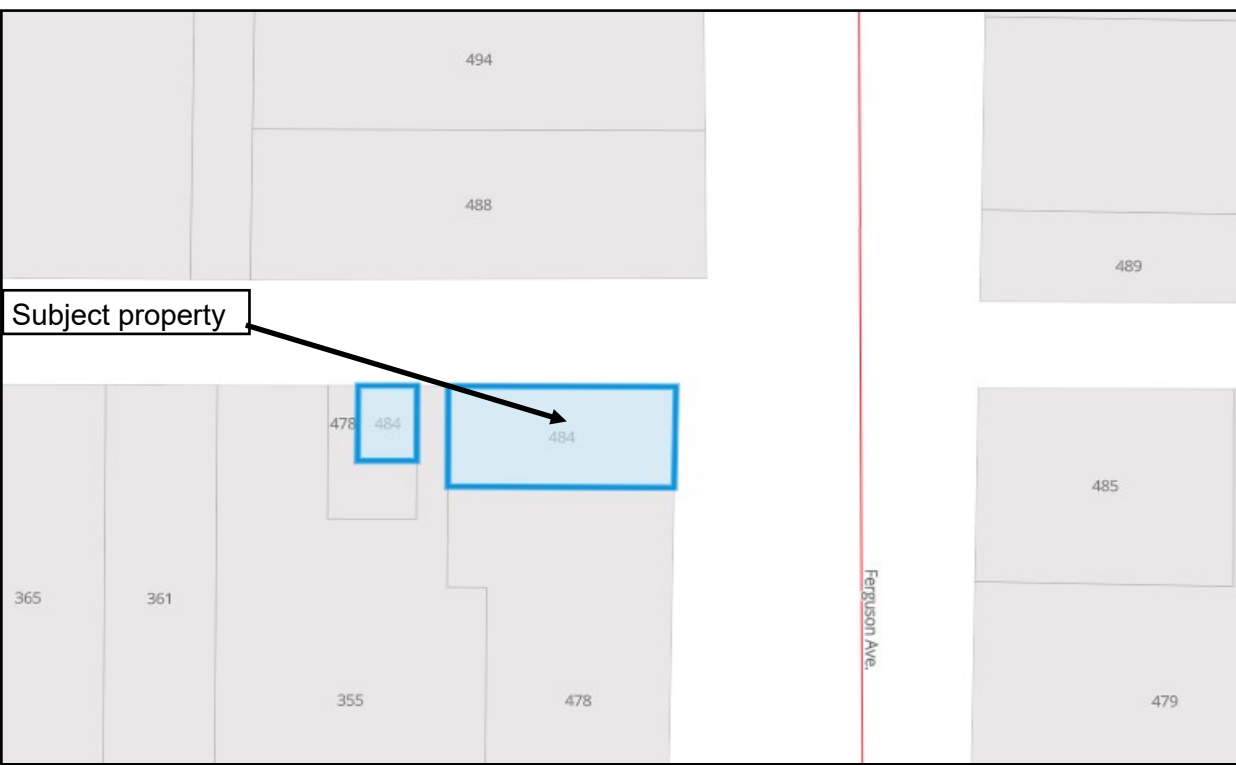
Place: Council Chambers at City Hall, 325 Farr Drive, Haileybury

- Animal must be registered with Temiskaming Shores Animal Services or be a Farm Animal.

Registration Required

- Registration is open on a first come first served basis.
- Proof of program qualifications must be submitted prior to the clinic date.
- Register for the Community Care Clinic by contacting the City Animal Control Officer.
