Public Works

Maintenance | Line Painting
The City of Temiskaming Shores will be undertaking center and edge line painting on various roadways beginning the week of June 9, 2025, weather permitting. This work is part of our annual road maintenance program to improve visibility and safety for all road users.

Motorists and pedestrians are advised to:

- ♦ Use caution when approaching painting crews and equipment
- ♦ Avoid driving over freshly painted lines, as this can damage the markings and transfer paint to your vehicle
- ♦ Expect minor traffic disruptions or lane closure in active work zones

The City of Temiskaming Shores is **not responsible for** damage to vehicles, clothing, or other property resulting from contact with wet paint. Drivers are reminded to obey all signage and avoid marked areas until the paint has fully dried.

Line painting is a weather-dependent activity and may be postponed or extended as necessary. We appreciate your cooperation and patience as we complete this important **safety work**.

2025 Roadway Resurfacing Program
Miller Paving is set to begin roadwork in Temiskaming Shores. Please drive cautiously in construction areas and around construction workers. Signs will be installed to indicate construction areas. 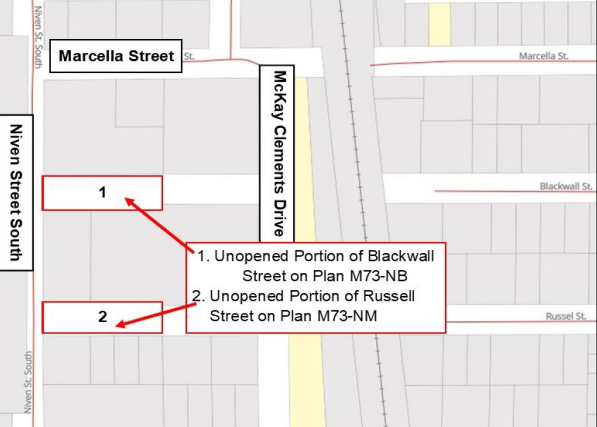

Notice is hereby given in accordance with By-law No. 2004-022 in respect to the permanent closure of a highway.

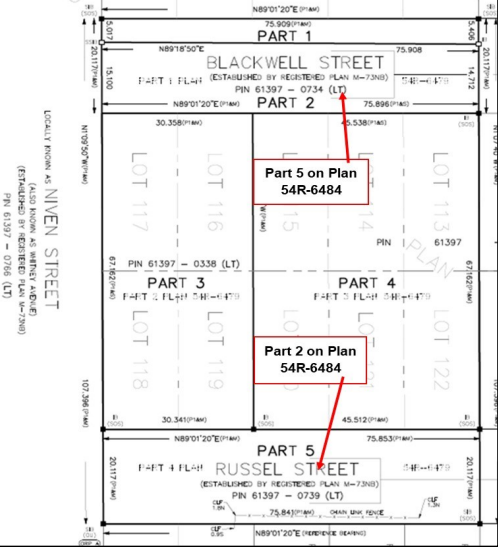
This public notice is being given to advise the public that Council will be considering the adoption of two by-laws to Stop up and Close:
