Proof of Income and Assets



- Most recent notice of assessment. Pay stub, proof of Ontario Works or Ontario Disability Support Program
- Past 60 days of banking (with full name and address visible)
- Portfolio of assets including TFSA, RIFS, GICs, RRSP, and all properties owned

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Property



- Have you owned or sold a home in the past 5 years, if so what was the value
- Value of home, based on MPAC Assessment, Tax Bill, Offer of Purchase and Sale

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Demographics



- Proof of Canadian Citizenship (Birth Certificate, passport, or baptismal certificate)
- Child Custody Documents (Separation Agreement, Court Order, signed mutual agreement between parents)
- Documents pertaining to priority status
