

Notes:
 Mineral Potential: The whole of the Temiskaming Shores Area is considered to have provincially significant mineral potential.
 Flood Elevation: All lands on the Lake Temiskaming shoreline below the elevation of 581.7 CGD are deemed to be subject to a flooding hazard.
 Heritage Resources: The shorelines of Lake Temiskaming, Wolf River, South Wolf Creek, Mill Creek, and Dixon Creek are considered to have high archaeological potential.
 Trails: The location of recreation trails may change over time.
