


The City of Temiskaming Shores (the City) has completed the environmental assessment for the New Waste Management Capacity project. As required under section 6.2(1) of the Environmental Assessment Act and according to the Terms of Reference approved by the Minister of the Environment and Climate Change on November 28, 2012, the City of Temiskaming Shores has submitted its environmental assessment to the Ministry of the Environment and Climate Change for review and approval.

Background

Currently, the City's waste is disposed of at its Haileybury Landfill Site. This site will reach its capacity in mid-2018. The City places emphasis on intensifying its waste reduction and recycling efforts but also identified the need for new waste management capacity. To address this need, the City has conducted an evaluation of the alternatives to managing waste and identified landfilling as the preferred alternative. Subsequently, an assessment on the alternative methods, in this case locations for the landfill, was conducted and expansion of the closed New Liskeard site was identified as the preferred alternative method.

Consultation

As required under the Environmental Assessment Act, the environmental assessment will be available for public review and comment from **September 2, 2016 to October 21, 2016**.
